Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

The **first reading** – Jeremiah teaches us that once we come to know and treasure God's word, we cannot keep this good new to ourselves, even if there is a price to be paid for our faithfulness.

The **second reading** - St Paul urges us to offer ourselves as a living sacrifice. This is a challenge; it is also a caution: a living sacrifice can always choose to leave the altar!

The Gospel – The cross and discipleship are inseparable. Jesus makes it clear that the cross is not a hindrance to his followers, but that we follow him by bearing our crosses in faith.

Joint parish pilgrimage to the tomb of St. Damien the leper priest of Molokai October midterm break. Thursday 26th of October to Sunday 28th 2017.

The trip will include a visit to the tomb of St. Damien of Molokai in the crypt of St. Anthony's church Leuven and newly renovated Damien Museum in Tremolo. We will also have the opportunity to visit the city of Bruges distinguished by its canals, cobbled streets and medieval buildings, forever immortalised in the Irish film "In Bruges". We will also pay a visit to The Menin Gate Memorial to the Missing, the famous war memorial in Ypres dedicated to the British, Irish and Commonwealth soldiers who were killed in the Ypres Salient of World War I and whose graves are unknown. The trip is 3 nights 4 days, half board, (B&B and evening meal) includes coach transport and ferry crossings. It does NOT include travel insurance, in order to keep the costs down this the personal responsibility of each pilgrim. Pickup and drop off from the parish. The cost is £350 per person sharing.
