## 5<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

As we come together to share the Sunday Eucharist, we find encouragement and nourishment to be the light of the world and salt of the earth that Christ calls his followers to be.

### Readings

**The first reading**, from the prophet Isaiah, finds the Lord demanding generosity, compassion and justice so that God's people may be a true light to the world.

**The second reading**, from St Paul, reminds the Corinthians that his message when with them came through the power of the Spirit and was of the crucified Christ and the power of God.

**The Gospel** – Jesus uses ordinary images, of salt and light, to describe how his disciples are to live in the world to purify, preserve, and penetrate society and as light-bearers, to live in the light of his truth and love. (Synopsis Intercom)
