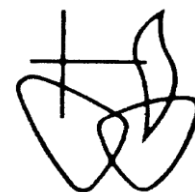

(TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME)

The First Reading – The woman is described as the man's 'helpmate.' Far from being a put-down, the same word is used of God himself elsewhere in the Bible (e.g. Ps 70:6).

The Second Reading – Jesus was made low, then raised high. We are called to follow him in his lowliness, so that God may raise us up.

The Gospel – Jesus is very concrete: when a man and woman come together, they are no longer two, but a single body. This aptly describes the procreative function of a man and woman, a function in which they act as a single organism, rather than as two.
