Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

The **first reading** – Through his prophet, God reminds his people that they have been yielding sour grapes, rather than the wholesome fruit of love and justice.

The **second reading** – Paul knows the reality of worry and anxiety. He also knows the antidote: 'Fill your minds with everything that is true, everything that is noble, everything that is good...'

The **Gospel** – Just as in the first reading, a vineyard features prominently in the gospel. God expects to find fruit in the lives of his people. We should not lean too heavily on the label 'Christian'; instead, we should ask where we are bearing fruit.
