**(TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME)**

**The First Reading** – God’s prophet has a word that is tailored to the faint-hearted: ‘Courage! Do not be afraid.’

**The Second Reading** – The letter of St James is steeped in practical Christianity. We are not to make distinctions on the basis of appearance or social standing – God himself has not done so.

**The Gospel** – Jesus frees the speech and hearing of a deaf and dumb man. We are all called to speak God’s praise and to hear his word.
