## Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

The **first reading** –We desire many things, and this reading encourages us to foster a desire for the wisdom that comes from God, through his word. This wisdom is ours for the desiring!

The **second reading** – St. Paul does not preach a gospel of easy certainties, but he wants his people to be absolutely certain that those who have died in faith are called to share in the life of God for eternity.

The **Gospel** – Jesus' parable makes it plain that a faith that does not impact on life, a faith that does not shed light, is as impractical and worthless as a lantern without oil. Faith is to be lived out, not merely spoken about.
