THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

The First Reading – It is in Jesus, our Consolation, that the ancient biblical command has been fulfilled: ‘Console my people, console them, says your God.’

The Second Reading – We are saved by ‘the cleansing water of rebirth.’ Christ, who joined sinners at his baptism, took their place on the Cross, and in this way opened for us the way to God.

The Gospel – After Christ’s baptism, the heavens open. This is a token of what the Lord would bring about for everyone: complete access to God and to eternal life.
