Know your faith, spread your faith: Our Blessed Mother: Catholics believe that worship is due to God alone. We do, however, venerate Mary. And without the Incarnation, we would not have salvation.** Mary is the most beautiful model of total submission to the will of God. **Catholics do not view Mary as equal to Christ, but rather venerate Mary because of her relationship to Christ, Our Lord and Saviour.** The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains, "Mary's role in the Church is inseparable from her union with Christ and flows directly from it" (CCC 964). As Catholics, we pray that we can respond to God's call to holiness for our lives in the way that Mary did.
