The collection last weekend 8th January 2017 was £2012.54 with approx £800 in standing orders.

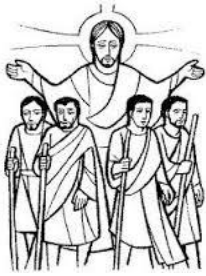

Opening Comment

Gathering to celebrate the Sunday Eucharist we give thanks for the gift of faith in Christ that enables us to see the hand of God and the Holy Spirit at work in our lives.

The first reading reveals God's promise through the prophet Isaiah of the one who will restore God's people to him and bring the light of salvation to the ends of the earth.

The second reading, from St Paul, brings Paul's greetings and prayers to his beloved Corinthians.

The Gospel, from John, bears witness to Jesus the Lamb of God revealed by the Holy Spirit as the one whose mission is to redeem us from our sins. (Synopsis Intercom)

Octave Prayer for Christian Unity - 18th – 25th January mass for the unity of Christians will be celebrated during the ferial days.

These words, known as the "Testament of Cardinal Mercier," are an impetus for the annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. The octave, eight days has been celebrated continuously since 1894.
