2ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The First Reading – God’s people will be brought from abandonment to delight – this is the promise God makes through his prophet.

The Second Reading – St Paul is at pains to emphasise the sheer variety of gifts given by the Spirit. Uniformity might be simpler, but the Spirit’s gifts bring great variety.

The Gospel – ‘Do whatever he tells you.’ This is Mary’s command, from at the heart of the wedding feast. Jesus’ word is followed, and the result is joy.
