Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The first reading – The Lord guides all events for the good of his people, so that they may be a blessing to others. Even the coming to power of a new leader in a conquering nation is embraced by God's providence.

The second reading – This is the beginning of the very earliest Christian writing. It sets out the themes that guide Christian living: grace, peace, faith, love and hope.

The Gospel – The Pharisees set out to trap Jesus with a question, but he turns the tables on them. Those who approach Jesus without sincerity are blind to the truth.
