## SUNDAY 24TH JUNE 2018 (THE NATIVITY OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST)

**The First Reading** – We can expect to be challenged by prophets like Isaiah and John the Baptist. God has, after all, made their speech like a sharp sword.

**The Second Reading** – John the Baptist was mentioned in the earliest Christian preaching: he heralded Christ and knew that he himself was a humble servant of the Messiah.

**The Gospel** – At John's birth the people wonder: What will this child turn out to be? It is natural to wonder what God has in store, and faith invites us to trust that all will be well.
