THIRTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: CHRIST THE KING

The First Reading – The sovereignty of God is repeatedly stressed. Our faith is not simply a private matter; it is a participation in God's plans for the world.

The Second Reading – We hear a beautiful title for Jesus: He is 'the faithful witness.' Jesus shows us the truth about God, about the world, about ourselves.

The Gospel – It seems that Jesus is on trial before Pilate, but it is Pilate who is on trial. We are all judged by our attitude to Christ and his goodness.
