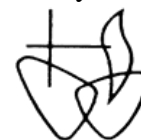

THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The First Reading – When the people hear God’s word and realize how they have failed to live by it, they are saddened. But then they are reassured: ‘The joy of the Lord is your stronghold.’

The Second Reading – St Paul uses the image of the human body to describe how different people with different gifts make up the church. We are not in competition, any more than a hand and a foot are in competition. We are all necessary.

The Gospel – What qualifies Luke to draw up his Gospel is his love for the truth of Jesus. We gain credibility from our closeness to Jesus.
