**Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

The **first reading** – The Lord does not leave his people wandering in darkness and error; he raises up prophets to guide them. Moses reassures people that God will continue to do this.

The **second reading** – St Paul was convinced that the Lord was about to return. It turned out that the Lord intended his followers to be here for the long haul. Still today, we are called to dedicate ourselves fully to the Lord's affairs.

**Gospel** – What was it that impressed Jesus' hearers? Not slick oratorical technique or sound bites, but his authority! Jesus was genuine, and people could not but recognise this.
