Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The first reading – God's anger and his compassion are two sides of a single coin. He is compassionate towards the weak; by the same token his anger is directed against those who prey on the weak and the vulnerable.

The second reading – The people to whom Paul writes received the good news of Jesus with great joy, in spite of the opposition they experienced. In this, they are a model for all whose faith is resisted or derided.

The Gospel – Jesus' opponents love to ask him difficult questions, but the Lord's sincerity overwhelms their malice, his truthfulness wins out over their deceitfulness.

Holy Day of Obligation – Wednesday November 1st, All Saints Day, is a Holy Day of Obligation. We will have Mass at 7am, 10am and 7pm.

November – the Month of the Holy Souls: The month of November is the Month of the Holy Souls. On 2nd November the Universal Catholic Church commemorates the souls of the faithful departed. We will have Mass at 7am, 10am and 7pm. Even though a particular day is fixed to remember the departed souls, the Church recommends that we remember our dear ones, visit their cemeteries and pray for them particularly during the entire month of November.

"A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to any of the faithful who (1) one of the days from 1-8 November visit devoutly a cemetery or simply pray mentally for the dead (2) on all Souls' Day visit a church or chapel with devotion and there recite the Our Father and the Creed.

A partial indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to any of the faithful who (1) visit devoutly a cemetery or who simply pray mentally for the dead; (2) recite devoutly Lauds or Vespers of the Office of the Dead, or the invocation 'Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord..' (*Diocesan - From: Liturgical Directory*)

Confirmation: We will soon be taking applications for those in year 10 or above, who wish to be considered for Confirmation in 2018. Application packs will be available in the back of the church throughout November. The closing date will be the first Monday in December.
