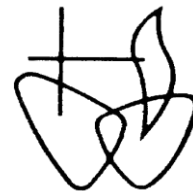

(TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME)

The First Reading – Moses shows us that one sign of an authentic prophet is the desire that all people be filled with God's Spirit.

The Second Reading – The rich are condemned, not because they have more than they need, but because they have turned a blind eye to those who have less than they need.

The Gospel – Like Moses, there is no jealousy or partisanship in Jesus: he wants everyone to do God's work; he wants all his disciples to shine with God's light.
